# Fu Jen Catholic University Regulations Governing the Establishment of the International Academic Exchange Committee

Approved at the Seventh Executive Council for the 2014-2015 Academic Year on April 9, 2015 Approved for Amendment at the First Executive Council for the 2015-2016 Academic Year on September 10, 2015

### Article 1

The University has established the International Academic Exchange Committee (hereinafter 'the Committee') in order to promote policies to internationalize the University and to increase its global competitiveness.

## Article 2: Composition of the Committee

1. The Committee is composed of 17 members, including the Vice-President of Academic Affairs, the Vice-President of International Affairs, the Dean of the Office of International Education, the Director of the Holistic Education Center, the Director of the School of Continuing Education, the Vice-Dean of the Office of International Education, and the Deans of each College. The Vice-President of Academic Affairs serves as Committee Chair, and the Dean of the Office of International Education serves as Committee Vice-Chair.

2. Committee members serve one term of two years and may be reappointed. The Committee will convene a meeting once per semester and may convene an extraordinary general meeting when necessary.

Article 3: Principal work of the Committee:

- 1. To promote the internationalization of the University.
- 2. To serve as a bridge between the University and individual Colleges, to announce policies for internationalizing the University, and to carry out the internationalization of all Colleges.

## Article 4

Committee meetings will be convened and led by the Committee Chair. If the Chair is unable to attend, the Vice-Chair will act as Chair for the meeting.

## Article 5

At least one-half of Committee members must be present in order to hold a meeting. A decision may only be passed with the agreement of one-half of members present.

## Article 6

Funding for the Committee and its work will be provided in the budget compiled by the Office of International Education.

## Article 7

These Regulations have been passed by the Executive Council and will be promulgated and implemented upon approval of the President. The same procedure will be followed for each amendment.
